Average Cost of Attendance for 2022-23

- Tuition and Fees: \$60,301
- Room and Meals: \$16,710
- Books and Supplies: \$1,250
- Personal Expenses: \$1,200
- Transportation: \$750
- **Total Cost: \$80,211**

Commitment

- 100% of demonstrated financial need is met
- 70% of undergraduates received some form of financial assistance
- \$55,100 is the median need-based University scholarship offered to first-year students
- \$5.35 million awarded in 2019/2020 by Notre Dame clubs to help reduce need-based borrowing

Statistics

- \$184 million in need based scholarship assistance in the 2021/22 academic year
- \$21,362 average Federal loan debt
- The three-year default rate among Notre Dame students who have entered repayment is less than 1%
- 98% of first year students return for their second year

Outcomes

- 95% of students graduate on time, one of the highest graduation rates in the nation
- 98% of students are placed in careers, graduate schools or service opportunities within six months of graduation
- 87% of pre-med graduates are admitted into medical school (nearly twice the national average)
- More than 450 employers visit campus every year for recruitment.
- More than 75% of our students complete internships during their four years
